This is the ride FOR OCER BY OCER! Your Board of Directors is the collective “ride manager”, and all proceeds for this ride will go directly to the club. This is how we fund the majority of our year end awards. While we have the management details covered, any and all participation from members and riders is how we’re going to make this ride the best it can be! We have already had some amazing ride awards donated, which GREATLY helps us put on this ride at minimal cost – if you have anything you would like to donate as a ride award, please reach out to a board member. We are also relying on membership for volunteers during the ride – please reach out if you are able to scribe, take pulses, work the timer table, help clean up, etc. on EITHER day.

DIRECTIONS: Chandler, OK is conveniently located between Oklahoma City and Tulsa on I-44. Take Exit #166 then turn North on Highway 18 and go 1/4 mile to 890 Rd. turn West (left). Go approximately 1 1/2 miles. Do not follow curve, continue West 2 miles into equestrian campground.

Campground: Public restrooms with showers, electric and primitive campsites. Tie poles with limited space for pens at most campsites. Electric sites are FIRST COME FIRST SERVE unless you reserve a group of 5 at a time – the city of Chandler does not take individual reservations. **Do not park in sites 6-10 as those are reserved for ride management.** All payments can be dropped off at the honor box in camp: \$22/night for electric, \$11/night for primitive, \$6/rider for trail use. BRING LARGE TRASH BAGS FOR MANURE.

Trails: Scenic established trails through woods and meadows.

Entry Fees: Cash or check payable to Ozark Country Endurance Riders

50 mile - \$95 / 25 mile - \$85 / Intro - \$35 / All juniors except intro - \$50

Important Stuff: No pre-entry, but it does help us prepare if you let us know you’re coming and what days you’re riding – just send Elisa a message. Current negative Coggins papers dated with 12 months must be presented for all equines in camp. Additionally, the State of OK requires health papers for all out-of-state equines. Bring clothes for all four seasons – you never know in late November!
